Defendants moved to dismiss Smolinski's sixth, seventh, eighth and tenth claims alleging that Miller investigate Smolinski in retaliation for exercising a Constitutional right in violation of California Civil Code §§ 51.7 and 52.1. The court has read the moving and responding papers and considered the arguments of counsel.

As explained at court, the defendants' motion to dismiss plaintiff's sixth claim is DENIED with respect to defendant Miller for the time period following his employment with the police
