STIPULATION AND ORDER TO AN
ACCELERATED SCHEDULE ON
DEFENDANTS' MOTION FOR A
PROTECTIVE ORDER
[Re Docket No. 88]

Defendants are moving under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26 for a protective order preventing Schafer from taking the deposition of defendant Payne until new counsel is retained by the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation to represent defendant Payne.
