**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING
PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR
LEAVE TO FILE A FIRST

The Court has considered plaintiff David Almeida's ("Plaintiff") motion for leave to file a first amended complaint and to set a new case management conference. The Court finds good cause exists to grant Plaintiff's motion. Accordingly, Plaintiff's motion is GRANTED.
