1 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT** Defendant OnlineNIC Inc. (“OnlineNIC”), and
2 OnlineNIC’s officers, directors, employees, representatives, agents, successors-in-interest,
3 parent corporations, subsidiary corporations, affiliated companies, and all other persons, firms
4 or entities acting in concert or participating with them, directly or indirectly, is prohibited from:

- 5 1. transferring, or allowing the transfer of any assets;
- 6 2. destroying, altering, secreting, transferring, or otherwise disposing of any
7 records of their business activities, whether on paper, in electronic format, or in any other
8 medium, and including without limitation all accounting records and all logs or other
9 documents relating to selecting, registering, trafficking in, monetizing, relating, assigning,
10 renewing, deleting, transferring, using and maintaining its domain names;
- 11 3. allowing any records of their business activities relating to selecting, registering,
12 trafficking in, monetizing, relating, assigning, renewing, deleting, transferring, using and
13 maintaining its domain names to be destroyed, altered, secreted, transferred, or otherwise
14 disposed of in the course of business or business activities, and shall instead take all affirmative
15 steps necessary to capture and record all such records, whether by copying, collection, backup,
16 or otherwise, either on paper, in electronic format, or in any other medium;
- 17 4. transferring, releasing, deleting, or assigning any domain names;
- 18 5. changing the companies or customer identification numbers used to generate any
19 monies from any of the domain names; and
- 20 6. assisting, aiding or abetting any other person or business entity in engaging in or
21 performing any of the activities referred to in subparagraphs 1-5 above,

22 This injunction shall not apply to transactions required in the ordinary course of lawful
23 business which are made in good faith and which do not deprive Plaintiffs of their ability to
24 satisfy their judgment.

25 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
