

Pending before the Court is Mark D. Baker's Application for Admission of Attorney Pro Hac 18 Vice. Upon review of the record in this action, the Court notes that his clients have not filed a 19 20 written consent to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction or request for reassignment to a United 21 States District Court judge for trial. This civil case was randomly assigned to United States Magistrate Judge Maria-Elena James for all purposes including trial. In accordance with Title 28, 22 U.S.C. § 636(c), the magistrate judges of this District Court are designated to conduct any and all 23 24 proceedings in a civil case, including a jury or non-jury trial, and to order the entry of final 25 judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal from a judgment entered by Magistrate Judge James may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same 26 manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district court. 27



You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and

disposition. Accordingly, Mr. Baker's clients, IAC Search & Media Inc. and Lycos Inc., shall inform the Court whether they consent to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction or request reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial.
