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1	DECLARATION PURSUANT TO CIVIL L.R. 6-2(a)
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3	I, BRUCE A. ERICSON, declare:
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5	1. I am a member of the bar of this Court and a partner with the law firm of
6	Pillsbury Winthrop Shaw Pittman LLP, attorneys of record for Cingular Wireless LLC
7	(now known as AT&T Mobility LLC), New Cingular Wireless Services, Inc. and Cingular
8	Wireless Corporation (now known as AT&T Mobility Corporation) (collectively,
9	"Cingular"), defendants in various cases consolidated before this Court as part of In Re
10	National Security Agency Telecommunications Records Litigation, MDL No. C-06-1791-
11	VRW. I make this declaration in support of the accompanying Stipulation to Stay Cases
12	Against Wireless Carriers ("Stipulation"). I have personal knowledge of the facts stated
13	herein and, if called as a witness, I could and would competently testify thereto.
14	2. By entering the Stipulation, the parties thereto seek to stay all proceedings,
15	including those proceedings transferred to this Court by the JPML and consolidated with
16	this MDL subsequent to entry of the Stipulation, against Cingular until after the final
17	adjudication of all appeals of this Court's July 20, 2006 ruling in Hepting, et al. v. AT&T
18	Corp., et al., including disposition of any petition for certiorari to the United States
19	Supreme Court (or the expiration of time to seek such a petition), without prejudice to the
20	rights of the parties.
21	3. There have been four (4) previous time modifications in this MDL
22	proceeding. See Dkts. 19, 52, 82, 112.
23	4. The Stipulation will only affect the schedule for this MDL as it applies to
24	Cingular. Under the Stipulation, Cingular need not file pleadings responsive to the various
25	consolidated complaints filed against them until sixty (60) days after the expiration of this
26	stay.
