1 WHEREAS, a Case Management Conference is scheduled in this case for December 17,  
2 2010 at 10:30 a.m.

3 WHEREAS, since the last Case Management Conference in July 2010, the parties have  
4 continued to work toward a resolution of the case by exchanging documents. The parties also  
5 entered into a Protective Order with respect to documents exchanged during discovery.

6 WHEREAS, the parties have not yet been able to schedule a mediation of the disputes  
7 between them because they need to exchange further documentation and take the depositions of  
8 Rule 30(b)(6) witnesses before participation in mediation would be meaningful.

9 WHEREAS, the parties submit that they are continuing to exchange documents with the  
10 aim toward resolution of the case.

11 WHEREAS, the parties submit that the currently scheduled Case Management Conference  
12 would be of little benefit to the Court or the parties, and the parties agree that a Case Management  
13 Conference scheduled approximately 90 days later would be appropriate.

14 It is therefore stipulated between the Parties that, subject to the approval of the Court, the  
15 Case Management Conference currently scheduled for December 17, 2010, should be continued  
16 to March 18, 2011 or the next available date thereafter on the Court's calendar.
