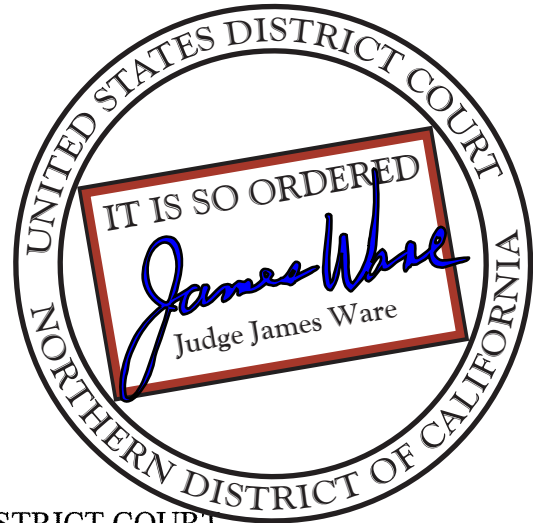

This case is scheduled for a Second Order to Show Cause re: Settlement hearing on October 25, 2010. Plaintiffs shall file its Motion in accordance with the Civil Local Rules which will be **October 25, 2010**. If a Stipulated Dismissal is filed on or before **November 19, 2010**, the hearing will be vacated. No further extension will be granted.
