To date, the parties have not submitted a Joint Pretrial Conference Statement. The Joint Statement as well as any 14 15 in limine motions were due on January 22, 2010. (See Preliminary Pretrial Conference Scheduling 16 Order (Bench Trial), hereafter, "July 8, 2009 Order," Docket Item No. 35.) Unless the parties are 17 currently engaging in advanced settlement discussions, the Court finds no good cause for the parties' 18 disregard of the Court's July 8, 2009 Order. However, in light of the scheduled March 8, 2010 19 hearing on Defendants' Motion for Leave to File Counterclaims, the Court finds good cause to 20 continue the Final Pretrial Conference. 21 Accordingly, the Court CONTINUES the Final Pretrial Conference to March 8, 2010 at 11 22 a.m. On or before February 26, 2010, the parties shall file a Joint Pretrial Conference Statement as 23 well as any in limine motions and any other filings required under the July 8, 2009 Order in 24 preparation for the upcoming March 16, 2010 trial.
