ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On January 5, 2010, the court issued an order requiring respondent to show cause why a writ of habeas corpus should not be granted. Respondent was ordered to file with the court an answer or a motion to dismiss within 60 days of the order. Respondent has not taken any action on this case. The court therefore orders respondent to file a declaration by August 26, 2010 showing good cause why the petition for writ of habeas corpus should not be granted for lack of opposition.
