retaliation, see Miller v. Maxwell's Int'l Inc., 991 F. 2d 583, 584, 587-88 (1993). Rather, a claim under Title VII can only be brought against an "employer." See Craig, 496 F. 3d at 1053-54.

Accordingly, plaintiff's Title VII claims against the individual defendants, specifically, Kathy Kaser, Tiffany Bass, Albert Mohu, Betty (Patty) Foster, and Joseph Sadek are hereby DISMISSED with prejudice, for failure to state a claim. <u>See</u> 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(ii).

The instant action shall proceed against defendant Denny's Corporation only.
