1 WHEREAS, Plaintiff Steven Nakash, individually and on behalf of an alleged class, filed
2 this action against nVidia Corporation (“NVIDIA”) on September 12, 2008 in the United States
3 District Court, Northern District of California, San Francisco Division, alleging claims related to
4 certain computer chips sold by NVIDIA;

5 WHEREAS, NVIDIA maintains its corporate headquarters and principal place of business
6 at 2701 San Tomas Expressway, Santa Clara, California, 95050;

7 WHEREAS, Civ. L.R. 3-2(e) provides that “all civil actions which arise in the counties of
8 Santa Clara ... shall be assigned to the San Jose Division”;

9 WHEREAS, the parties agree that this matter should be assigned to the San Jose Division
10 pursuant to L.R. 3-2(e);

11 WHEREAS, there are currently other actions pending in the San Jose Division that
12 involve some or all of the same parties, and appear to arise out of the same essential facts and
13 circumstances, and transfer of this action to the San Jose Division would facilitate coordination
14 and/or consolidation of this action with such other actions; and

15 WHEREAS, the Court may transfer this action to the San Jose Division pursuant to Civ.
16 L.R. 3-2(f).

17 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED, by and between the parties to this action through their
18 designated counsel, that this action be transferred forthwith to the San Jose Division.
