7 **A. Pertinent Facts**

8 All of the issues in this matter, except one, have been either adjudicated by this Court or
9 agreed on by the parties. Plaintiff’s disability benefits have been reinstated and back disability
10 benefits have been paid in accordance with the Court’s order in this matter. Plaintiff’s claim for
11 attorney’s fees and costs has been settled and this settlement amount has been paid. Finally, the life
12 insurance benefit, provided in conjunction with plaintiff’s disability insurance coverage, has also
13 been reinstated.

14 However, the parties have been unable to resolve the issue of the amount of life insurance
15 coverage and the coverage provided to plaintiff’s husband. In order to give the parties additional

17 request that the June 11, 2010 Status Conference in this matter be continued at least thirty days in
18 order for the parties to have additional time to resolve this remaining issue.

21 counsel of record, Sean Nalty, hereby stipulate that the June 11, 2010 Status Conference in this
22 matter can be continued thirty (30) days to allow the parties additional time to resolve the remaining
23 issues regarding the life insurance coverage provided to plaintiff.
