(hereafter, "Statement," Docket Item No. 64.) In 16 their Statement, Defendants represent that they intend to file a Motion for Summary Judgment¹ on 17 the issue of whether the officer Defendants have qualified immunity as to Plaintiffs' Section 1983 18 claim. (Statement at 10.) In light of the anticipated dispositive motion, the Court finds that a 19 Preliminary Pretrial Conference would be premature at this time. Accordingly, the Court 20 VACATES the Preliminary Pretrial Conference. 21 The Court will set a new Conference date, if necessary, in its order addressing the anticipate 22 motion for summary judgment. 23 Dated: March 24, 2010
