On October 5, 2010, the court denied the petition, entered 18 judgment in favor of respondent, and declined to issue a certificate of appealability. Petitioner 19 20 has filed a notice of appeal and a motion to waive filing fees on appeal. The court construes 21 plaintiff's motion as an application to proceed IFP on appeal. Because the court declined to issue a certificate of appealability in the order denying 22 the petition, petitioner's request to proceed IFP on appeal (docket no. 32) is also DENIED. 23 24 When the court declined to issue a certificate of appealability in the order denying the 25 petition, it determined that there were no valid grounds for an appeal.
