 17 Having been sentenced on September 19, 2005 to a term of imprisonment for being a
 18 felon in possession of a firearm, defendant Michael Hamp is presently out on bond pending his
 19 surrender date. By court order dated September 20, 2005, the conditions of his release were
 20 modified to remove electronic monitoring. Mr. Hamp has continued to comply with his release
 21 conditions in the ensuing weeks.

22 Mr. Hamp and his fiancée wish to travel to the Sacramento area to visit friends over the
 23 upcoming weekend. Under the terms of his release, Mr. Hamp's travel is restricted to the
 24 Northern District of California. Because Sacramento is in the Eastern District of California,
 25 traveling there without the Court's permission could constitute a violation of his release
 26 conditions.

1 The government does not oppose Mr. Hamp's brief trip to the Eastern District.
2 Accordingly, the parties agree and stipulate that Mr. Hamp shall be allowed to travel to the
3 Eastern District of California between Thursday, November 17, 2005 and Monday, November
4 21, 2005. All other conditions of Mr. Hamp's release shall remain in effect.
