
Dear Mr. Hartnett:

This communication is with regard to the subpoena that was issued by the U.S. District Court Northern District of California with regard to Case No. 1:07-cv-02103 (LLS) and related Case No. 1:07-cv-03582 (LLS), both pending in the Southern District of New York. I have been informed that you granted BayTSP an extension of time until Nov. 7, 2007 in which to object or otherwise respond to the subpoena. We are still in the process of retaining counsel and are confident that this will be accomplished within the next few days. We will have them review the categories of documents you have requested and be prepared to provide a detailed response to your request by November 7, 2007.

At present, BayTSP objects to each and every one of the requests as being outside the proper scope of discovery of those cases, unduly burdensome and oppressive, vague and ambiguous, and impermissibly calling for attorney-client privilege and work product information. BayTSP objects to the definitions set forth in the subpoena, in particular but not limited to the definition of "You", "Your", and "BayTSP". In reviewing the requests, BayTSP will use the common everyday and ordinary meaning of the word in the requests. Further, BayTSP objects to the requests because they call for the production of confidential, trade secret and proprietary information of BayTSP and its customers. In addition, Bay TSP objects to the production of documents for inspection and copying at Metro Legal Services c/o Benders Legal Services in San Jose.

Once retained, our counsel will contact you between now and Nov. 7 in an effort to try to resolve some or all of BayTSP's objections.

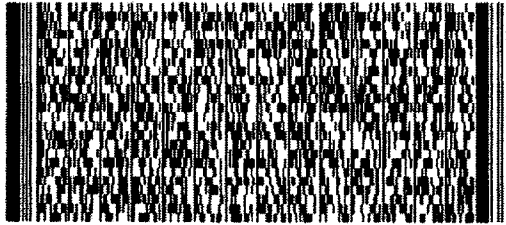

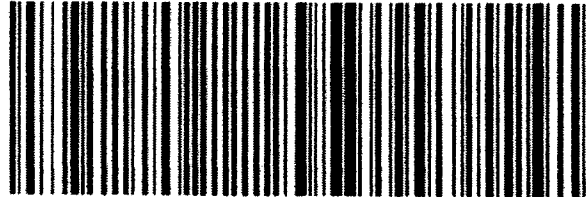
