Pending before this court is defendant Chase Home Finance, LLC's motion to dismiss the complaint. This court previously issued two clerk's notices reminding the parties that this case has been assigned to a United States magistrate judge and directing them to file either a consent or declination form. Defendant Chase Home Finance LLC has consented. Plaintiffs have not responded.¹

This civil case was randomly assigned to the undersigned magistrate judge for all purposes including trial. In accordance with Title 28, U.S.C. § 636(c), the magistrate judges of this District Court are designated to conduct any and all proceedings in a civil case, including a jury or non-jury trial, and to order the entry of final judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal from a judgment entered by the undersigned may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same manner as an appeal from any other

judgment of a district court. The parties have the right to have the case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and disposition. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED THAT plaintiffs shall file either a consent or declination to proceed before a United States magistrate judge **no later than April 24, 2009**. The consent and declination forms are available at the Clerk's Office and may also be obtained from the court's website at <http://www.cand.uscourts.gov>.
