**ORDER DENYING
ADMINISTRATIVE MOTION TO
FILE UNDER SEAL**
(Re: Docket No. 265)

On June 8, 2010, Plaintiff Metteyya Brahmana (“Brahmana”) filed an administrative motion to file under seal Exhibit A, B, and C video depositions as exhibits to Brahmana’s opposition to a then-pending motion for summary judgment. Pursuant to Civil L.R. 79-5, Defendants Phillip Charles Lembo, CyberData Corp., Numonix Inc., Conquest Technology Limited, and Cameron Barfield (“Defendants”) had to file with the court and serve a declaration establishing that Exhibits A, B, and C are sealable, or to withdraw the designation of confidentiality. Defendants did not file or serve any such declaration.¹ Accordingly, the court
