Plaintiff, a prisoner at the Correctional Training Facility ("CTF") in Soledad, California, has filed a <u>pro se</u> civil rights action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 alleging claims against CTF prison officials. After a review of the amended complaint, the Court found plaintiff's allegations that he was unlawfully denied his First Amendment right to practice religion by defendants. On April 12, 2010, the Court ordered the amended complaint served upon defendants, and directed defendants to file an answer.

Defendants have filed a motion to submit the case to mediation or, in the alternative, for an extension of time to file dispositive motion. (Docket No. 34.) Good cause appearing, the motion to submit the case to mediation is GRANTED. The instant case will be referred to Magistrate Judge Vadas for mediation proceedings pursuant to the Pro Se Prisoner Mediation Program. The proceedings will consist of one or more conferences as determined by the mediator. The proceedings shall take place within 90

days of the date this order is filed. Magistrate Judge Vadas shall coordinate a time and date for the mediation proceedings with all interested parties and/or their representatives and, within 5 days after the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, file with the court a report for the prisoner mediation proceedings.

For the foregoing reasons and for good cause shown,

- 1. The clerk shall mail a copy of the court file, including a copy of this order, to Magistrate Judge Vadas in Eureka, California.
- 2. This action is hereby STAYED, except to the extent necessary to conduct the mediation proceedings ordered herein, until further order of the court, if necessary, following completion of the mediation proceedings.
