

1 Plaintiffs herein, by and through their counsel, submitted an Amended
2 Petition, which differed from the original Petition only in that the future payouts
3 to be received by the minor Plaintiffs have decreased due to a drop in prevailing
4 interest rates during the period of time the original Petition was pending.
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6 Upon review of the file and consideration of the Petition and Amended
7 Petition, the Declarations of Plaintiffs' counsel and supporting documentation
8 submitted therewith, and the opposition and/or non-opposition of any Defendant
9 provided to the Court prior to the making of this Order, the Court does hereby
10 find and order as follows:
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12 GOOD CAUSE APPEARING,
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14 1. The minor Plaintiffs' claims against the Defendant City of Hollister, the
15 County of San Benito, and the individually-named employee-defendants of said
16 entities, as compromised pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement and
17 General Release (as described in the Petition), the periodic payment schedule
18 (Exhibit A to the Amended Petition, and to the Declaration of Dennis R. Ingols
19 in Support of the Amended Petition), and the Non-Qualified Assignment and
20 Release (of Periodic Payment Obligation, redacted to protect the minor's
21 privacy - Ex. B to the Declaration of Dennis R. Ingols in Support of the
22 Amended Petition), is approved.
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1 2. Plaintiffs' counsel may attach the fully-executed, non-redacted settlement
2 documents, including the Settlement Agreement, and Exhibits A and B to the
3 Declaration of Dennis R. Ingols in Support of the Amended Petition, when
4 obtained, to this Order for purposes of submitting same to The Prudential
5 Insurance Company of America, Pruco Assignment Corporation, and/or Ringler
6 Associates.
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9 3. The Court approves the distribution of attorneys' fees and costs to
10 Plaintiffs' counsel as set forth in the Petition.


11 4. The Court approves of the dismissal of all claims, of all Plaintiffs, as against
12 Defendants City of Hollister, the County of San Benito, and the individually-
13 named employee-defendants, and all employees of said entities, with prejudice.
14 Plaintiffs' counsel shall submit such dismissal promptly after the
15 annuity/annuities set forth in the settlement documents have been funded, and all
16 other due consideration has been received by Plaintiffs' counsel.
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19 5. In the event that the annuities are not fully funded by the time the current
20 rate quote expires on June 15th, 2009, and a new quote must be generated, the
21 parties, The Prudential Insurance Company of America, Pruco Assignment
22 Corporation, and/or Ringler Associates may proceed to execute and fund the re-
23 quoted annuities without need for further order of this Court, so long as the
24 future payments to be received by minor Plaintiffs do not increase or decrease
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1 more than five percent (5%), and all other terms of the structured settlement
2 remain the same (input amounts, dates of future payments, distribution between
3 Plaintiffs and their counsel).
