

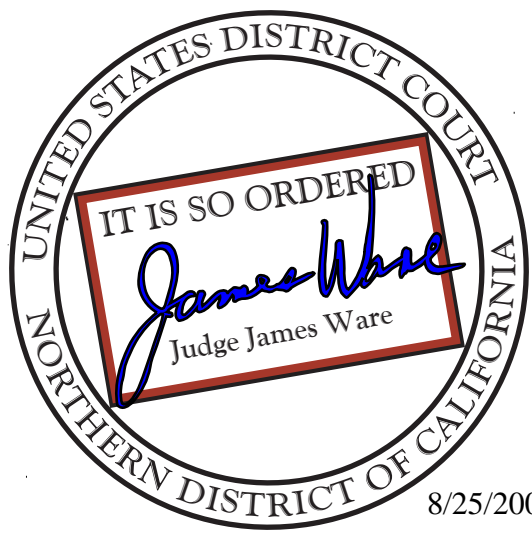


24 Plaintiffs Jeffry and Jennifer Schulken and defendant JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. hereby
