



1 to be appointed class counsel, containing a description of his qualifications, the work he  
2 has done in identifying or investigating potential claims in this action, and the resources  
3 he intends to commit to representing the class;

4 (2) An explanation of the basis of the proposed incentive awards for the Plaintiffs;

5 (3) An explanation as to why the proposed incentive awards are characterized as  
6 “statutory damages” in the proposed notice;

7 (4) Information with respect to Resurgent's finances that supports the parties’  
8 contention that the proposed \$25,000 settlement fund represents approximately 1% of  
9 Resurgent’s net worth; and

10 (5) An explanation as to why the parties failed to identify in the proposed settlement  
11 agreement the party responsible for paying the costs of class administration.

12  
13 The matter thereafter shall be submitted without further argument.
