ORDER<sup>1</sup> EXTENDING THE PERIOD  
TO REACH FINAL SETTLEMENT

17           On February 2, 2011, the Court entered an order of dismissal based on a notice from the  
18 parties that they had reached a settlement in principle. The order stated that if any party were to  
19 advise the Court within ninety days that the agreed consideration had not been delivered, the  
20 Court would vacate the order of dismissal. In the interim, Defendant Robert Chase died,  
21 complicating the process of obtaining the necessary releases to finalize the written settlement.  
22 Accordingly, the Court will extend the period for the parties to finalize their written settlement  
23 by an additional ninety (90) days.
