On February 2, 2011, the Court signed an order of dismissal <sup>1</sup> following notice from the

Court would vacate the order of dismissal. Subsequen	tly, Defendant Robert Chase died,	
complicating the process of obtaining the necessary rel	leases to finalize the written settlement.	

On May 18, 2011, the Court extended the period for the parties to finalize their written settlement
by an additional ninety (90) days.

On July 29, 2011, the United States notified the Court that the settlement had not yet been finalized but that "the parties will be able to finalize a settlement in the near future." Notice at 1
