17	This action was removed to this court from state court on September 18, 2009. Pursuant to
18	the Scheduling Order for Cases Asserting Denial of Right of Access under Americans with
19	Disabilities Act Title II & III (42 U.S.C. §§ 12131–89), the last day for Plaintiff to file a "Notice of
20	Need for Mediation" was February 11, 2010 (45 days after the Joint Site Inspection, which that orde
21	set as December 28, 2009). Plaintiff failed to file any such notice, and other than a dismissal of
22	Defendant Ramada Worldwide, Inc., there is no activity reflected in the docket of this case since it
23	was removed from state court. On September 28, 2010, this court entered an order setting a deadline
24	of October 12, 2010 for Plaintiff to show cause why the case should not be dismissed for failure to
25	prosecute. Plaintiff has not filed any response to the order to show cause. Therefore,
26	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this case be reassigned to a District Judge. ¹

28	Magistrate Judges have authority to issue dispositive orders only in cases where all partie have consented to Magistrate Judge jurisdiction. See 28 U.S.C. § 636(c)(1). ORDER, page 1
