In light of the Order entered by the Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit on October 16, 2012, plaintiff is ordered to appear for his deposition at the earliest practicable time, no later than October 31, 2012. The motions hearing and Case Management Conference presently set for November 1, 2012 is vacated.
