At the hearing held on May 11, 2011, the Court expressed concern that the documents filed by Defendant Chase Home Finance, LLC as Docket No. 51 contained information possibly required to be redacted, such as a taxpayer ID number, account number, or other personal information. Accordingly, the Court ordered Defendant to file a redacted version of the documents by May 13, 2011. Instead, Defendant filed a motion seeking to seal all of the documents submitted as Docket No. 51 in their entirety.

The Local Rules of this Court require that all requests to file under seal be “narrowly tailored to seek sealing only of sealable material.” Civ. L.R. 79-5(a). Defendant’s request to seal all of Docket No. 51 does not comply with this rule. Accordingly, Defendant’s motion to seal is denied without prejudice. In order to protect Plaintiff, the Court will temporarily restrict public access to Docket No. 51. However, Defendant must file a renewed motion to seal that includes a

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redacted version of the documents and complies with Civil Local Rule 79-5(c) by May 27, 2011.
