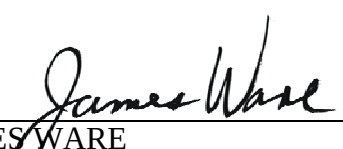

16 Presently before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion to Consider Whether Cases Should be
17 Related. (See Administrative Motion to Relate, hereafter, "Motion to Relate," Docket Item No. 69.)
18 Plaintiff seeks the Court's determination as to whether Haiping Su v. National Aeronautics and
19 Space Administration, et al., Case No. C 09-2838, should be related to Haiping Su v. United States,
20 et al., Case No. C 10-00222. Plaintiff contends that both cases concern substantially the same
21 parties and events, and unduly burdensome duplication of labor and expense would result if the
22 cases were conducted before different judges. (Motion to Relate at 2).

23 Since the two cases are both already assigned to Judge Ware, finding them related would
24 serve no further purpose. Accordingly, the Court DENIES Plaintiff's Motion to Relate as
25 unnecessary. If Plaintiff wishes to consolidate the cases, he shall file the appropriate motion.
