18           On May 22, 2010, Plaintiffs notified the Court that the above-entitled matter has reached  
 19 a settlement. (See Docket Item No. 9.) In light of the settlement, the Court vacates all trial and  
 20 pretrial dates. On or before **June 18, 2010**, the parties shall file a stipulated dismissal pursuant  
 to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a).

21           If a dismissal is not filed by the specified date, all parties shall appear in Courtroom No.  
 22 8, 4th Floor, United States District Court, 280 South First Street, San Jose, Ca on **June 28,**  
 23 **2010 at 9 a.m.** and to show cause, if any, why the case should not be dismissed pursuant to  
 24 Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b). On or before **June 18, 2010**, the parties shall file a joint statement in  
 25 response to the Order to Show Cause. The joint statement shall set forth the status of the  
 26 activities of the parties for finalizing the settlement and how much additional time is requested  
 27 to finalize and file the dismissal. If a voluntary dismissal is filed as ordered, the Order to Show  
 28 Cause hearing will be automatically vacated.

Failure to comply with any part of this Order will be deemed sufficient grounds to dismiss this action.
