My name is Fayola Delica, and I am writing this letter in regard to objecting to the settlement case with the Google Buzz User Privacy. I have been using a Gmail account for educational purposes because my school uses email as a primary means of communication. Therefore, I am making such request because I feel that the settlement is not really in the benefit of the individuals like myself, whom have had their privacy rights violated and/or have or at risk of being a victim of identity theft. As I have been a victim of identity theft in the past, it is a very stressful experience and makes one feel that one's security and safety has been robbed from them.

It seems that the settlement is neglecting the users of Google Buzz and more in favor for the public. The settlement has been placed in a fund to educate people, but there is no compensation for us, the ones who are victims of such negligence and violation. We, the class members, should be able to receive some compensation from this settlement. I am not against educating people of their privacy rights and ways to prevent such violation, but this is letting Google Buzz off the hook in not servicing in the best interest of their customers as well as respecting their privacy. I believe that the settlement funds should be divided amongst the users of this service and that a small portion of the settlement should be placed in a fund as already considered.

As I am a graduate student and class will be in session on the hearing date, I will not be in attendance for the hearing. I do hope that my proposal will be taken into consideration as the court makes a decision on this settlement case. I do thank you in advance for your time and assistance with this matter.

Google rarely contacts Gmail users via email, but we are making an exception to let you know that we've reached a settlement in a lawsuit regarding Google Buzz (<http://buzz.google.com>), a service we launched within Gmail in February of this year.

Shortly after its launch, we heard from a number of people who were concerned about privacy. In addition, we were sued by a group of Buzz users and recently reached a settlement in this case.

The settlement acknowledges that we quickly changed the service to address users' concerns. In addition, Google has committed \$8.5 million to an independent fund, most of which will support organizations promoting privacy education and policy on the web. We will also do more to educate people about privacy controls specific to Buzz. The more people know about privacy online, the better their online experience will be.

Just to be clear, this is not a settlement in which people who use Gmail can file to receive compensation. Everyone in the U.S. who uses Gmail is included in the settlement, unless you personally decide to opt out before December 6, 2010. The Court will consider final approval of the agreement on January 31, 2011. This email is a summary of the settlement, and more detailed information and instructions approved by the court, including instructions about how to opt out, object, or comment, are available at <http://www.BuzzClassAction.com>.

This mandatory announcement was sent to all Gmail users in the United States as part of a legal settlement and was authorized by the United States District Court for the Northern District of California.
