

1 Pursuant to Local Rule 6-1(a), the undersigned counsel of record for Plaintiffs Normand Perron
2 and G. David Hatfield (“Plaintiffs”) and Defendant Hewlett-Packard Company (“Defendant”)
3 stipulate and agree that Defendant has until June 11, 2010 to answer, move or otherwise respond
4 to Plaintiffs’ initial Class Action Complaint (“Complaint”) as follows:

5 WHEREAS, Plaintiffs filed the Complaint on February 18, 2010;

6 WHEREAS, Defendant executed and returned a waiver of service of the Complaint on
7 February 23, 2010;

8 WHEREAS, on April 16, 2010, Plaintiffs and Defendant agreed to extend Defendant’s
9 Defendant’s deadline to answer, move or otherwise respond from April 23, 2010 until April 30,
