2. The parties may file a stipulation or administrative motion pursuant to Civil Local Rule 7-11 for consideration by the court in order to modify the briefing deadlines for any further summary judgment motions. However, the court will not modify the

3. The parties shall file an updated Preliminary Pretrial Conference Statement **on or before June 18, 2013.**
