15	Plaintiff, a former state prisoner proceeding <i>pro se</i> , filed a civil rights complaint pursuant
16	to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 alleging that Chief Edward Flores, Captain David Sepulvedo, and Sheriff
17	Lawrance of the Santa Clara County Jail violated his constitutional rights. On August 25, 2010,
18	the Court sent a notification to Plaintiff informing him that he did not file a completed non-
19	prisoner in forma pauperis application, nor had he paid the required filing fee. The Court
20	provided a copy of the non-prisoner in forma pauperis application, along with a return envelope,
21	and a notification that the case would be dismissed if Plaintiff failed to pay the fee or file a
22	completed application with supporting documentation within thirty days. No response has been
23	received from Plaintiff.
24	As Plaintiff has not filed a completed non-prisoner in forma pauperis application or paid
25	the filing fee, this case is DISMISSED without prejudice. The Clerk shall close the file.
