Before the Court are Defendants' motions for an extension of time to file their 19 dispositive motion. 20 On October 22, 2010 and November 22, 2010, Defendants filed motions for an extension 21 of time to file their dispositive motion. On November 30, 2010, Defendants filed a motion for 22 summary judgment. Defendants' motions for extension of time are GRANTED, and 23 Defendants' motion for summary judgment shall be deemed timely filed. 24 Defendants also filed a motion to stay discovery pending a ruling on their motion for 25 summary judgment. A district court has broad discretion to stay discovery pending the 26 disposition of a dispositive motion. See Panola Land Buyers Ass'n v. Shuman, 762 F.2d 1550, 27 1560 (11th Cir. 1985). 1	the dispositive motion may not dispose of the entire case. <i>Id.</i> Here, should Defendants' motion
2	for summary judgment be granted, it would dispose of the entire case. Moreover, the Court
3	should stay discovery until it resolves the question of qualified immunity. See Crawford-El v.
4	Britton, 523 U.S. 574, 598 (1998). Accordingly, the Court GRANTS Defendants' motion to stay
5	discovery until disposition of Defendants' motion for summary judgment.
6	This order terminates docket numbers 25, 31 and 34.
7	IT IS SO ORDERED.
