1 Pursuant to Local Rule 6-1 and the agreement of the parties herein, plaintiffs
2 and defendants have agreed, subject to Court approval, to continue all dates related
3 to plaintiffs' pending motion for default judgment by **one week** in this action
4 because should the Court grant defendants' motion to set aside entry of default –
5 scheduled to be heard this Friday, January 7, 2011 – plaintiffs' motion for default
6 judgment will be rendered moot. The parties request the entry of an order in
7 substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

8 WHEREAS defendants' have filed a motion to set aside entry of default
9 scheduled to be heard by the Court this Friday, January 7, 2011;

10 WHEREAS plaintiffs' motion for default judgment is scheduled to be heard
11 on January 28, 2011 and defendants' opposition to that motion is due January 7,
12 2011;

13 WHEREAS should the Court grant defendants' motion to set aside entry of
14 default judgment, plaintiffs' motion for default judgment will be rendered moot;

15 WHEREAS, should the parties be forced to brief plaintiffs' motion for
16 default judgment but the Court grants defendants' motion to set aside entry of
17 default on January 7, 2011, it would result in an unreasonable waste of the parties'
18 and the Court's resources;

19 THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties,
20 through their respective counsel, that the deadlines related to the motion for default
21 judgment be extended by **one week** as follows:

22 (a) The deadline for defendants' opposition to plaintiffs' motion for
23 default judgment, currently set for January 7, 2011, shall be continued to
24 **January 14, 2011**;

25 (b) The deadline for plaintiffs' reply in support of its motion for default
26 judgment, currently set for January 14, 2011, shall be continued to **January 21,**
27 **2011**;

1 (c) The hearing date for plaintiffs' motion for default judgment, currently
2 set for January 28, 2011, shall be continued to **February 4, 2011**.
