IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Plaintiff is deemed to be representing himself *pro se*. While the court usually requires an attorney move to withdraw before being relieved as counsel of

record, it appears Ms. Mosley has never actually appeared in this action. Thus, a motion for leave to withdraw is neither necessary or appropriate. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all documents filed with the court must be served directly on Plaintiff. Defendant Regional shall promptly serve on Plaintiff a copy of all motion papers it filed on August 18, 2010.
