

1 4. The parties wish to avoid the potential uncertainty, expense and delay of litigation and
2 have therefore reached an agreement for settlement.

3 IT IS THEREFORE STIPULATED by and between the parties, through their respective
4 counsel that:

5 1. The parties have entered into a settlement agreement that contains a fair and just
6 negotiated resolution to the current dispute between the parties in this case; and

7 2. This action should be dismissed with prejudice.
