Plaintiff responded, indicating that he had been out of the country for several weeks because of a death in his family and that he "intends to make monthly payments to preserve the preliminary injunction and will do so prior to the hearing date of this motion." Pl.'s Op. 2:13-17. However, Ocwen filed a supplemental declaration on July 28, 2011, stating that as of that date Plaintiff still had not made any payments pursuant to the injunction. Edwards Decl. ¶ 2. Ocwen's reply also included deposition testimony by Plaintiff indicating that he earns between \$4,000 and \$12,000 per month. Id., ex. A. At the hearing on August 5, 2011, Plaintiff's counsel indicated that Plaintiff did not intend to meet the condition of the injunction.

The Court enjoined Defendants from taking possession of the property on the condition that Plaintiff make monthly payments. No payments have been made in the intervening two and half months, and it appears that Plaintiff does not intend to make any such payments. Accordingly, Defendants' motion is granted, and the injunction is hereby dissolved.
