1 In the event that the JPML denies transfer of the Google Wi-Fi cases, and all  
2 subsequently-filed related actions, to a single judicial district for coordinated or  
3 consolidated pretrial proceedings, Google shall have thirty days from the date of the  
4 order denying transfer to plead, answer, move, or otherwise respond to plaintiffs'  
5 class action complaint; and

6 In the event that the JPML orders the transfer of the Google Wi-Fi cases, and  
7 all subsequently-filed related actions, to a single judicial district for coordinated or  
8 consolidated pretrial proceedings, Google shall plead, answer, move, or otherwise  
9 respond to plaintiffs' class action complaint within thirty days from (a) the date that  
10 plaintiffs file a master consolidated complaint in the transferee district or (b) the  
11 date that it is resolved by the transferee court and/or counsel for plaintiffs and  
12 Google that no master consolidated complaint will be filed.
