(See Docket No. 7.) Thereafter, plaintiff was granted an extension of time to file an amended complaint. (Docket No. 9.) Plaintiff has filed a request for a second extension of time to do so. (Docket No. 10.) Good cause appearing, the motion is GRANTED such that plaintiff is granted an extension of 60 days. Plaintiff shall file an amended complaint, correcting the deficiencies discussed in the court order filed January 31, 2011, **no later than June 30, 2011**.

The amended complaint must include the caption and civil case number used in this order and the words "AMENDED COMPLAINT" on the first page and write in the case number for this action, Case No. C 10-03217 JW (PR). Because an amended

complaint completely replaces the original complaint, plaintiff must include in it all the claims he wishes to present. See Ferdik v. Bonzelet, 963 F.2d 1258, 1262 (9th Cir. 1992). Plaintiff may not incorporate material from the original complaint by reference.

Failure to file an amended complaint in the time provided will result in the dismissal of this action without prejudice and without further notice to plaintiff.

This order terminates Docket No. 10.
