
**ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR PARTIES

18 On August 20, 2010, defendants moved to dismiss pursuant to Rule 12(b)(6), or in the  
19 alternative, for more definite statement. This case has been assigned to a Magistrate Judge. Before  
20 the court takes any action on the motion to dismiss, the court must determine whether or not all of  
21 the parties who have appeared consent to Magistrate Judge jurisdiction, or whether any of the parties  
22 request reassignment to a District Judge. Therefore,

23 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no later than September 17, 2010, each party who has not  
24 already done so shall file either a "Consent to Proceed Before a United States Magistrate Judge," or  
25 else a "Declination to Proceed Before a United States Magistrate Judge and Request for
