

ORDER GRANTING STIPULATION OF
DISMISSAL

On June 13, 2012, Plaintiffs Brocade Communications Systems, Inc. and Foundry Networks, LLC (“Plaintiffs”), and Defendant David Cheung, stipulated that all claims and defenses between Plaintiffs and Mr. Cheung in the above-referenced action shall be dismissed without prejudice.
