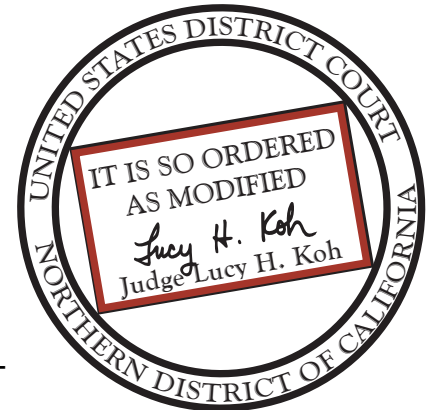

4 California Code Of Civil Procedure Sec. 877.6 ("Motion") is set for hearing in  
5 June 17, 2011, at 1:30 p.m., to be followed by the previously scheduled  
6 this department on ~~June 16, 2011, at 1:30 p.m.~~ Case Management Conference.

- 8 2. Quality's Motion must be e-filed and e-served on or before ~~May 27, 2011.~~
- 9 3. Opposition pleadings, if any, must be e-filed and e-served on or before ~~June~~  
10 ~~7, 2011.~~ June 9, 2011.
- 11 4. Reply pleadings, if any, must be e-filed and e-served on or before June 13,  
12 2011.
- 13 5. Quality's obligation to respond to Defendant TIN's written discovery is  
14 stayed pending the determination of the underlying Motion. If the underlying  
15 Motion ultimately is denied, Quality will be obligated to respond to the  
16 discovery on a schedule to be agreed upon by Quality and TIN and approved  
17 by the Court.
