12	Presently before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment. ¹ In its Motion,
13	Plaintiff requests compensatory damages for its conversion claim as well as attorney fees and costs.
14	(<u>Id.</u>) However, upon review, Plaintiff has not provided any evidence to support its claim of \$1,200
15	for Defendant's alleged conversion. In addition, Plaintiff has not provided an accounting of attorne
16	fees or costs in any of its filings. (See Docket Item No. 10.)
17	Accordingly, on or before February 24, 2011, Plaintiff shall file adequate proof of the value
18	of its property at the time of conversion to support its compensatory damages claim. Failure to
19	timely file the required evidence is deemed to be a waiver of Plaintiff's conversion claim. Plaintiff
20	shall also file a supplemental declaration and provide an account of its request for attorney fees and
21	costs. Failure to timely file the required accounting is deemed to be a waiver of fees and costs.
