- That the Respondent SHALL NOT enter the residence of KAREN B YOUNG at 1100 EVERGREEN AVE, FREDERICK, MD, 21701. (Residence includes yard, grounds, outbuildings, and common areas surrounding the dwelling.)
- 4. That the Respondent SHALL STAY AWAY from:

5. This Order supersedes and overrides any previously entered Interim Peace Order issued by a Commissioner.

### KAREN B YOUNG VS ROBERT DR CROUCH NOTICE TO RESPONDENT

A Peace Order Petition alleges that you have committed one or more prohibited acts. On the basis of the Petition this Temporary Peace Order has been issued. Violation of this Temporary Peace Order may be a crime or contempt of court or both, and result in imprisonment or fine or both.

In order to respond to the allegation(s) contained in the Petition, you must appear in court at the Final Peace Order hearing as notified on page 1 of this Temporary Peace Order. If at the hearing the Court finds by clear and convincing evidence that a prohibited act occurred within 30 days before the filing of the Petition, and is likely to occur in the future, the Court may issue a Peace Order against you, whether you appear or fail to appear, and may order all or part of the relief requested by the Petitioner or granted in this Temporary Peace Order. This relief may include an order to: refrain from committing or threatening to commit a prohibited act; refrain from contacting, attempting to contact, or harassing the Petitioner; refrain from entering the Petitioner's residence; remain away from the Petitioner's place of employment, school, or temporary residence; participate in counseling; mediation; and pay the cost of these proceedings. A Peace Order may be effective for as long as six (6) months.

If you fail to appear in court and a Peace Order is issued against you, you will be served by first-class mail at your last known address with the Final Peace Order and all other notices concerning the Peace Order. The Peace Order will be valid and enforceable whether you are or are not in court and whether you do or do not actually receive it. You also may obtain a copy of the Peace Order from the District Court clerk. It is your responsibility to notify the court in writing of any change of address.

### **NOTICE TO ALL PARTIES**

Each party may be represented by an attorney at the Peace Order hearing. Due to the emergency nature of the hearing, however, the hearing may be held even if a party requests more time to obtain an attorney.

Doctor charged with sex offense, possession of pot

Frederick police officers charged an 83-year-old urologist with a fourth-degree sexual offense and possession of marijuana after he allegedly made sexual advances toward a woman.

Robert D. Crouch Sr. told the woman "everyone needs sex" because "it's just like breathing," according to charging documents filed in Frederick County District Court.

Crouch's office is at 900 Toll House Ave. He did not return calls for comment Monday night.

A person who answered the telephone at his office said Crouch was with patients and could not come to the phone.

Police were called to a home on Evergreen Avenue about 6 p.m. Sunday for a reported sexual assault, according to the Frederick Police Department.

A 43-year-old woman reported Crouch, from whom she had been renting a room, began making sexual advances toward her immediately after she moved in earlier this month, according to court documents.

She told officers the advances occurred almost every day, the court documents state.

The woman said Crouch inappropriately grabbed her several times before leaving the house that night, the documents state.

She gave police a description of his car. Officers found and stopped Crouch on Seventh Street near Magnolia Avenue close to Frederick Memorial Hospital, the documents state.

Additional officers went to the house to speak with the woman.

The woman, a student at Hood College, told police that Crouch had sexually assaulted her several times, the documents state. However, she did not report the earlier incidents, when he demanded sexual favors, because she worried about becoming homeless.

Instead of paying cash for rent, Crouch told the woman she could clean the house and take care of his pets, the documents state.

The woman reported that, earlier this month, she was studying when Crouch put a pornographic video into a DVD player. She insisted he turn it off, but he responded by grabbing himself and said, "I'm a doctor, I know what you need."

The woman also told police Crouch had previously offered her marijuana, the documents state. She reported that she believed he might have some in his car.

During the traffic stop, Crouch gave officers permission to search his car. Under the driver's seat, police found a large bag containing about five grams of marijuana.

Crouch was arrested and charged with fourth-degree sexual assault, second-degree assault and possession of marijuana, police said.

Officers took Crouch to Central Booking, where he appeared before a district court commissioner and was released on a written promise to appear in court.
