2 If the plaintiff fails to prosecute or to comply with these rules or a court order, the court  
3 may dismiss the action. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b). Accordingly,

4 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff show cause why the case should not be dismissed  
5 for failure to prosecute. Plaintiff shall respond in writing no later than March 2, 2011. If  
6 Plaintiff fails to show cause, this case will be reassigned to a district judge with a recommendation  
7 for dismissal.
