16 On August 9, 2011, the court ordered Appellant Orthodontic Education Company to show
17 cause in writing why this case should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution after Appellant failed
18 to comply with Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 8006. See Docket Item No. 6. The court
19 admonished Appellant that the court would dismiss this action with prejudice should it fail to
20 respond or otherwise fail to show good cause.
