 - 4. Swan consents to an entry of a permanent injunction enjoining him from:
 - Initiating or procuring transmission of unsolicited commercial electronic messages ("spam") on or through Facebook's computers, Facebook's website, Facebook's networks, or to Facebook users without Facebook's express written consent;
 - b. Creating or maintaining any Facebook Pages without Facebook's express written consent;
 - Creating or maintaining any Facebook applications without Facebook's express written consent;
 - d. Creating, directing, maintaining, or profiting from any marketing campaign directed at Facebook users without Facebook's express written consent;
