

Currently pending before the court is Plaintiff’s Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis*.
Based on the application and the file herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, no later than January 11, 2011, Plaintiff shall file either a
“Consent to Proceed Before a United States Magistrate Judge,” or else a “Declination to Proceed
Before a United States Magistrate Judge and Request for Reassignment.” Both forms are available
from the Clerk of the Court, or from the Forms (Civil) section of the court’s website at
www.cand.uscourts.gov. Absent consent, a Magistrate Judge is not authorized to rule on certain
matters, such as requests to proceed *in forma pauperis*. See 28 U.S.C. § 636(c)(1); see also, e.g.,
Tripati v. Rison, 847 F.2d 548 (9th Cir. 1988). After receipt of whichever form Plaintiff chooses to
file, the appropriate judge will rule on the pending application.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Case Management Conference scheduled for
December 28, 2010 is CONTINUED to 2:00 p.m. on February 18, 2011.
